



Tax Efficient Giving

Whether you give to the Church as a one-off, occasionally or regularly, if you are a UK tax payer you can give in a way that boosts the amount that you give and it may save you tax as well!

Boost your giving

- Sign a Gift Aid Declaration
- Fill in a Gift Aid Envelope with your gift

For every £1 you give under Gift Aid, the Church can reclaim 25p.

For every £1,000 you give under Gift Aid the Church can reclaim £250.

In the last financial year the Church reclaimed £85,551 under Gift Aid.

Reduce the tax that you pay

- If you are a basic rate (20%) tax payer unfortunately there is no personal benefit to you
- If your marginal rate of tax is 40% you can reclaim 20% of the taxable gross of your gift or 25% of the net. Hence for £1,000 you give by Gift Aid you can claim tax relief of £250.
- If your marginal rate of tax is 45% you can reclaim 25% of the taxable gross. Hence your tax relief would increase to £312.50.

Gift Aid Declaration

Attached is a Gift Aid Declaration

- If you are a UK tax payer, please fill it in to enable the Church to reclaim Gift Aid on your giving.
- If you cease to pay tax, please inform the Treasurer and he will not reclaim Gift Aid on your gifts from the point you give notification.
- If you move house, please complete a new form as the reclaim form is based on your address.
